POSITION DESCRIPTION:

They will also be responsible for obtaining materials for the line (cartons, lids, labels, etc.), or bulk fill (as required).

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Production Line:

- Performs packing line duties, including bulk (as required)
- Forklifting as required (finished pallets, cartons, lids, etc.)
- Monitors quality of packaging and finished products (i.e. bottles, lids, labels, and honey colour)
- Performs changeover/setups in conjunction with the rest of the team
- Maintains required production records (i.e., production code dates, check weights, cases packed, etc.)
- Daily cleaning as required
- Overtime may be required
- Other duties as assigned
