CASH SETTLEMENT INFORMATION SHEET

- A crop year runs from August 1st – July 31st
- **The deadline for all honey deliveries is January 31st each year**
- The maximum pounds allowed to be shipped to the Cooperative in a crop year is 10,000 lbs. unless approved by the Manager
- Producers must be a registered beekeeper with the Department of Agriculture in their respective province and provide the registration number on the application form.
- **All honey must be delivered in Bee Maid barrels**
- A \$25.00 refundable deposit is required on all barrels. This deposit will be paid back upon the return of the drums to the Cooperative, empty or full.
- The producer must book a delivery appointment by calling the office. **Appointments are required throughout the year.**
- When honey is delivered, it is weighed to determine the net weight. (Bee Maid barrels have a tare weight of 51 lbs. each)
- At that time the producer will receive a Truck Receipt showing the weights and number of drums.
- Honey must be graded before payment is made. This usually takes 2-3 days, though it may take longer during the busy season of August – October.
- An initial payment is made after the honey is graded.
- When the graded honey has been posted to the Cash Settlement producers' account, a Honey Receipt will be mailed out which shows the dollar amount paid.
- Interim payments are typically made January 15th, March 15th, June 15th and a final payment November 15th.
- Cash Settlement producers receive 90% of the contract members Pool B price and less 3 cents per pound for testing.

CONDITIONS FOR THE DELIVERY OF CASH PURCHASE POLICY

I understand that the Cooperative will supply drums for a refundable deposit of \$25.00 each and that this deposit will be returned to me when the barrels are returned to the Cooperative. Honey will only be accepted in Cooperative drums and these drums **MUST NOT** be used for the storage of beeswax. Under the Cooperative's quality control program, honey delivered in containers used for other purposes will not be accepted.

A maximum of 10,000 lbs. of honey may be delivered under the Cash Purchase Policy for each crop year unless approved by the Manager.
