

THE 2023 BEE MAID FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP

The Bee Maid Fiftieth Anniversary Scholarship was created in 2004 to commemorate the formation of Bee Maid Honey Limited in 1954. Bee Maid's fifty years of service to its members was an outstanding achievement. The Scholarship will recognize and encourage children and grandchildren of our members and staff as they enter post-secondary study. The Scholarship is also available to students applying to the Commercial Beekeeping Program at Kwantlen Polytechnic University.

The Scholarships are designed to stimulate the pursuit of excellence by rewarding outstanding achievement. The scholarships are also intended as a process by which young people can bring fresh ideas and innovation to the Bee Maid family.

VALUE

Two separate scholarships will be awarded, each valued at \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be either:

- A child or grandchild of a member of the affiliated producer coops: (Alberta Honey Producers Co-operative Limited, Manitoba Cooperative Honey Producers Limited) OR the child or grandchild of an employee of an affiliated cooperative or Bee Maid Honey. The applicant must not be a previous recipient of The Bee Maid Fiftieth Anniversary Scholarship and must be enrolled or applied for enrollment at an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada.

OR

- An individual applying to the Commercial Beekeeping Program at Kwantlen Polytechnic University in British Columbia.

SELECTION PROCESS

Each recipient will be selected on the basis of:

- Academic achievement in the previous year.
- Evidence of community involvement.
- A 500-1000 word essay on one of the topic questions provided on the application.

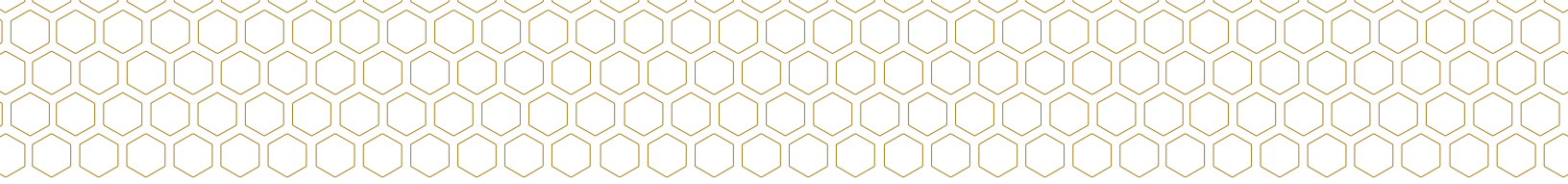

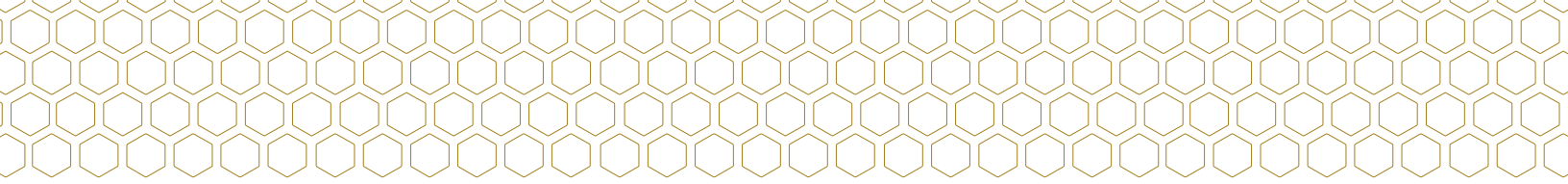
1. Trends in honey consumption: Canada, North America, and the World.
